Clinton holds a lead among Asian Americans, new survey says

Democratic nominee Hillary Clinton holds nearly a 4-to-1 lead over Donald Trump among registered Asian-American voters, according to the <u>National Asian American Survey</u>.

The National Asian American Survey found that 55 percent of voters said they were likely to vote for Clinton, compared to 14 percent for Trump.
